Spend the day getting to know Cuba's capital city, Havana. Visit the famous Plaza del la Revolucion, where Fidel Castro addressed more than a million Cubans on many occasions. Lining the square are important government buildings, including the Palace of the Revolution, the seat of the Cuban government. Have lunch at a local Paladar in Old Havana, a UNESCO Heritage Site. Take a guided walking tour around the old city, visiting the Plaza de Armas, the Used Booksellers Market, Plaza del la Catedral and La Florida Bar. Visit the fascinating Christopher Columbus Cemetery. Return to the hotel to freshen up for dinner at a local Paladar.

Continue your exploration of Havana on Friday with a focus on the arts. Visit the impressive Fine Arts Museum, where you can view anything from Greek ceramics to Cuban pop art. Interact with artists as you visit them in their studios. And gain new appreciation for street art on your tour of Muraleando.

After breakfast, drive a half hour outside of the city to Finca Vigia, Ernest Hemingway's Cuban home. The home is on the World Monuments list and is now a museum dedicated to the writer. Return to Havana and step into the past as you take a fun tour around the city in a Classic American Car. Disembark your car at the historic Hotel Nacional and join its long list of celebrities who have enjoyed its famous signature drink. This evening's farewell dinner will be at one of Havana's famed Paladars.

Say goodbye to Cuba as you board the Lakani Private Jet bound for Bogota, Colombia, where an Executive Suite awaits your arrival.


Explore the fascinating capital of Colombia today. Your guide will take you to Plaza Bolivar, lined by prominent government buildings such as Palace of Justice, Colombian Congress, the Mayor's Office, and the Primary Cathedral of Bogota. In the center of the plaza is a statue of Simon Bolivar, founder of Colombian independence. Colombia's rich cultural heritage has been cultivated by a population descending from native inhabitants, Spanish colonists, Africans, and immigrants from Europe and the Middle East. This is evident in its art and music. Colombia's most famous artist, Fernando Botero, has received international acclaim and many of his works are housed in the Botero Museum in La Candelaria. Lose yourself in Botero's recognizable "oversized" paintings and sculpture. Tour the Presidential Palace, then ascend to the summit of Monserrate, and capture a panoramic view of Bogota and beyond.

Become immersed in local daily life on an excursion to Paloquemao market, where 750 merchants gather together with an abundant offering of fruits, vegetables, dairy products, meats, and flowers. Then visit the Gold Museum, home of one of the finest collections of Pre-Hispanic gold in the world. Make sure to see the Muisca Raft, sometimes called the El Dorado Raft, referring to the ceremony of the legend of El Dorado that it represents.

A clear advantage of traveling by private jet is evident today as we land in Cartagena to visit its UNESCO World Heritage Site monuments en route to Panama. Arrive in Cartagena in time for lunch at a traditional Colombian restaurant. Then stroll through the historic walled city with your English-speaking expert. Pass through the Puerta Del Reloj into the Plaza de los Coches and learn about the city's colorful history from your guide. Step into Plaza San Pedro Claver and visit its church, both named after the Spanish Jesuit missionary who fought for social justice.

After your visit in Cartagena, you will continue your journey to Panama, the southernmost country in Central America. Panama City is a delightful combination of the historic and the ultra modern and has one of Latin America's richest histories. Executive Residence suites are reserved at your hotel.

Fly by helicopter over the Panama Canal en route to an Embera indigenous village on the banks of the Chagres River, where you are greeted with dancing and music. Pass under the Bridge of the Americas, which spans the Pacific entrance to the canal.

Casco Viejo is home to the Presidential Palace, Metropolitan Cathedral and other iconic landmarks that offer testament to the city's rich history, culture and heritage.

\$69,950 per person (double occupancy)

\$5,595 single supplement

Included in tour price: All regional private jet flights, between Cancun and Panama City; all beverages including liquor on the private jet; deluxe rooms at finest hotels on share basis; single accommodations and suite upgrades are available at additional cost; (Lakani reserves the right to substitute hotels for those named in the brochure when necessary); three meals per day, a la carte where available or practical; bottled water, coffee and tea with meals on the ground; special events; transportation by deluxe air-conditioned vehicles and motor coaches; entrance fees for comprehensive sightseeing; knowledgeable local guides; services of Lakani tour managers; gratuities to hotel and restaurant staff, local guides and drivers, Lakani tour managers; baggage portage throughout including two medium sized pieces of baggage; airport taxes; amenities package; transfers between airport and hotel in overseas gateway cities at the beginning and end of the trip; medical evacuation insurance of \$100,000 for covered reasons.

Not included in tour price: Airfare from hometown to Cancun and from Panama City to hometown; trip cancellation insurance; medical and accident insurance; passport and visa fees; personal expenses (such as mini bar, laundry, telephone, fax, and internet charges); inoculations and medications; other gratuities not specifically mentioned as included.

Payment requirements: To confirm your reservation, we require an initial deposit of \$5,000 per person. A second deposit of \$30,000 per person by July 14, 2017, and the balance is due September 30, 2017.

Refunds & Cancellation Policy: All requests to cancel confirmed reservations must be received in writing.

July 15 – August 31, 2017: \$25,000 per person

September 1, 2017 to departure: NO REFUND

Travel documents: Lakani World Tours does not obtain personal travel documents or assume responsibility for notifying travelers of current requirements. All expenses incurred as a result of delays or itinerary changes related to lack of appropriate travel documents shall be borne by the individual traveler.
