





Nairobi, KENYA

Discover the place where the heavens meet the earth, where the rhythm of nature pounds to the beat of an African drum, and where life is all about a revival of the senses.

Drive to Tarangire National Park which is famous for its huge number of elephants, baobab trees and tree climbing lions. Visitors to the park can expect to see any number of resident zebra and wildebeest in addition to the less common animals. Other common animals include waterbuck, giraffe and olive baboons.

This morning drive to Ngorongoro where we will visit Olduvai Gorge enroute, an ancient homind archaeological site, located in the Great Rift Valley. The excavations by Louis and Mary Leakey in the mid-1950's were important because they established the African origin of humankind. Ngorongoro Crater, one of Africa's most fascinating wildlife spectacles, is 12 miles in diameter caldera and harbors many species of animals including the elusive black rhino. Enjoy lunch in the crater floor during the game viewing drive.

DAYS 6 – 9 • Meals: BLD**Serengeti/Arusha & Depart Home**Serengeti Serena Lodge/**Four Seasons**

Depart for the Serengeti which is another one of the great game reserves and the jewel of Tanzania. Enroute visit a Maasai Village (Manyatta) for some unique cultural experience. The name Serengeti is derived from the Maasai word for "endless plains" and this is where millions of animals move in the ancient rhythms of the seasons. Enjoy an unforgettable hot air balloon ride, floating high above the Serengeti and landing to a luxurious champagne breakfast. Your game drives provide views of zebra, giraffe, Thomson's and Grant's gazelle, eland and klipspringer. Return to Arusha to board your flight back home or on to your next destination.

Cape Town & Depart Home

One & Only Cape Town

Fly to Cape Town. Take a city tour to see Government Avenue, the National Gallery, the South Africa Museum, Houses of Parliament, and the City Hall. Ride a cable car up to Table Mountain and witness the majestic views of Table Bay, Robben Island, the Atlantic Seaboard, and most of the Cape Peninsula.

Head through the suburbs of Sea Point, Clifton, and Camps Bay before continuing to the fishing harbor of Hout Bay. Wander Chapman's Peak and the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. Ride the funicular to the lighthouse to see the convergence of the Atlantic and Indian Oceans. Visit Boulders Beach to see the African penguins, the naval base at Simonstown, and the Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden.

Enjoy the Cape Winelands region's famous wine estates and partake in tasting the local vintages. Visit the villages of Paarl, Franschhoek, and Stellenbosch. Transfer to the airport for your departure flight.

DAYS 1 - 3 • Meals: BLD

Parc National des Volcans

Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge

On arrival at Kigali Airport, you will be met and taken on a scenic 3 hour drive to Parc National des Volcans. The journey north goes through beautiful terraced hillsides that characterize much of Rwanda's landscape, gradually climbing to the base of the awesome Virunga Volcanoes, sometimes with as many as five peaks visible. You will be driven to the magnificent Governors' Camp Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge, perfectly situated in the foothills of the mighty Virunga Volcanoes.

Tracking the gorillas on the slopes of the Virungas is a magical experience. When you reach the gorillas you are allowed to spend an hour with them, and often you will be back in time for a late lunch. Some gorilla families however are more elusive, and tracking can take a full day, especially when it is the rainy season. However, falling under the gaze of a great silverback makes any trek seem worth it. Return to the lodge and rest or if arriving back early at the lodge, there are opportunities for bird watching, mountain biking or guided walks around the lodge.

Another primate adventure awaits you in the Virunga heartland. Trekking the golden monkey, a subspecies of blue monkey, found only in the bamboo forests of the volcanic mountain chain that forms a part of the boundary between Rwanda and Uganda. Hiking through dense strands of bamboo interspersed with open glades, your guide will lead you to the habitat of groups of "habituated" golden monkeys who have become accustomed to human presence.


Time permitting, you can visit local community socio-economic and conservation projects run by SACOLA, the community trust that owns the lodge, and by African Wildlife Foundation and its local partner, the International Gorilla Conservation Program and learn about the exceptional work being done by these organizations. Explore the bustling town of Ruhengeri with its vibrant colorful markets and observe their local handicrafts such as basketwork and pottery.

Today you will be transferred to Kigali for overnight. Visit the Kigali Memorial Center and local handicrafts. Next morning transfer to the airport for your return flight home or on to your next destination.
