

ISRAEL - THE HOLY LAND REVEALED

Included in tour price: All chartered flights between Nairobi and back to Nairobi. Deluxe rooms at finest hotels/lodges on share basis; single accommodations are available at additional cost; (Lakani reserves the right to substitute hotels for those named in the brochure when necessary); three meals per day, a la carte where available or practical; bottled water, coffee and tea with meals on the ground; special events; transportation by deluxe air-conditioned vehicles and motor coaches; entrance fees for comprehensive sightseeing; knowledgeable local guides; services of Lakani tour managers; gratuities to hotel and restaurant staff, local guides and drivers; baggage portage throughout; airport taxes; amenities package; transfers between airport and hotel in overseas gateway cities at the beginning and end of the trip; medical evacuation insurance of \$50,000 for covered reasons.
