



Hiking through dense strands of bamboo interspersed with open glades, your guide will lead you to the habitat of groups of "habituated" golden monkeys who have become accustomed to human presence.

Time permitting, you can visit local community socio-economic and conservation projects run by SACOLA, the community trust that owns the lodge, and by African Wildlife Foundation and its local partner, the International Gorilla Conservation Program and learn about the exceptional work being done by these organizations. Explore the bustling town of Ruhengeri with its vibrant colorful markets and observe their local handicrafts such as basketwork and pottery.
