




HELSINKI, FINLAND
THU & FRI, SEP 7 & 8
Hotel Kamp

Arrive in Finland's capital city, Helsinki. Enjoy VIP treatment and assistance at the airport and transfer to your hotel. Meet fellow travelers and your Lakani Tour Managers at an evening cocktail party.

BAKU, AZERBAIJAN
SAT, SUN & MON, SEP 9, 10 & 11

Dine in Baku's charming Mugam Club while being entertained by live Azerbaijani and Mugam music.

Drive along the Baku Boulevard, the coastal promenade also known as Seaside Park. Learn about the country's rich history in textiles at the Azerbaijan Museum of Carpets. In 2010, UNESCO proclaimed them a "Masterpiece of Intangible Heritage." Visit the Fire Worshipper's Temple, the Holy place of Zoroastrians and see the impressive natural phenomenon at Yanar Dag, continually ablaze due to the steady seep of gas from under the surface of the sandstone.



ISLAND OF CRETE, GREECE
TUE, WED & THU, SEP 12, 13 & 14
Elounda Beach Hotel & Villas

Take the Lakani Private Jet to Heraklion, Crete. The largest of the Greek Islands is renowned for its rich history and crystal clear beaches.

Gain an insider's view of Cretan culture and history during your exploration of the ruins of Knossos Palace. Settled as early as the Neolithic period, Knossos has been called Europe's oldest city and the Bronze Age palace once held 18,000 people.

After a typical Cretan lunch, discover more Minoan civilization artifacts in the impressive Heraklion Archaeological Museum. Stroll and browse the city's charming shops and cafes.

Visit a family-run vineyard in the wine region of Peza and learn how to make some of Crete's specialties in a cooking class. Enjoy the fruits of your labors accompanied by some of the estate's finest wines.

MOSTAR, BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA
FRI, SEP 15
DAY STOP

Travel by Lakani Private Jet to Mostar, Bosnia and Herzegovina. Tour the city and see its most famous landmark, Stari Most, the old bridge that spans the Neretva River and is an UNESCO World Heritage Site. Discover the Byzantine, Ottoman, and Slavic influences as you explore the city.

Re-board the jet and continue across the Adriatic to Bologna, the capital of Emilia-Romagna, a region long been considered the Cradle of Italian cuisine.

BOLOGNA, ITALY
FRI, SAT & SUN, SEP 15, 16 & 17

Begin your exploration of Bologna with a shopping trip to the local market with your local hostess. Learn how to make pasta from an expert followed by lunch in a private home. Work off your lunch with a walking tour of Bologna's historic center and admire the medieval Asinelli Tower, a symbol of Bologna for 900 years that stands over 318 ft high. Visit the impressive Anatomical Theatre of the Archiginnasio with its remarkable ceiling and wall decorations, carvings and its ornate anatomical table where university students from the 16th century would have learned about human anatomy and surgery. Tour the unique Santo Stefano Basilica complex and then end the afternoon inside the 13th-century Church of Santa Maria della Vita.

Drive to Modena and get a thrill as you enter the Modena Racetrack (Autodromo di Modena) and be driven in a Ferrari, with the engine being pushed to its limits.

After lunch, stop in Maranello to visit the Enzo Ferrari Museum, where you will see an exhibition of Ferrari cars and memorabilia owned by Enzo Ferrari. On your way back to Bologna, you'll have a chance to sample balsamic vinegar at a local producer.
