

SABYINYO SILVERBACK LODGE

You are on your way to your exclusive cottage hidden amidst tropical forest in the foothills of the mighty Virunga Mountains adjacent to the Volcanoes National Park.


You are briefed on the trek into the hills and informed of gorilla etiquette and then feel the excitement surge as you are carefully guided to where the mountain gorillas are expected to be. Spend a quiet exhilarating hour with these magnificent, endangered creatures. Perhaps you are lucky to see babies or young gorillas during their playtime. The staff in the park monitor the gorilla families and are familiar with their location, but the gorillas are in their natural habitat and are free to move around. This thrilling, rare encounter is one that you will be talking about for years to come.

There are plenty of other activities available here, including a trek to see the Golden Monkeys, bird watching, and visits to a local village where you learn how the residents are involved in conservation of nature's wonderful gifts.

**MAASAI MARA GAME RESERVE, WESTERN KENYA
AUGUST 04, 05 & 06**

GOVERNOR'S IL MORAN TENTED CAMP

Leaving the magnificent gorillas behind, your private charter flight takes you to Kenya where you clear immigration and customs and transfer to your private turbo prop safari aircraft flying right into the heart of stunning Masai Mara, home to the world's greatest wildlife spectacle – the annual Great Migration of wildebeest and zebra. Your luxurious tented camp along the banks of the Mara River is your base for your wildlife exploration. Embark on morning and afternoon wildlife drives with a chance to see the 'Big 5' animals – elephant, buffalo, rhino, leopard, and lion – that inhabit the reserve. You'll be awakened with tea or coffee each morning and then head out just as the animals arise to hunt or graze. Stop for a coffee and snack in the bush and then return to camp for a fabulous breakfast. Later in the day, your guide takes you on a mid-afternoon drive to see more animals. This time, you'll break for sundowners with snacks before returning to camp for a delicious dinner. Then perhaps indulge in some stargazing before bed.



One morning, rise early and take an unforgettable Hot Air Balloon safari, soaring above the plains as the sun rises. This wonderful and different perspective of the African landscape and wildlife is followed by a champagne breakfast in the bush. It truly is a fantastic experience and one you will remember forever.

Head north to Kenya's wild northern frontier aboard your private charter flight. Laikipia is off the beaten track where more endangered species can be seen than anywhere else in East Africa. Note the efforts in conservation and environmental protection during your stay here. Your luxury cottage is spacious and elegant, with floor to ceiling windows revealing sweeping views across the Laikipia landscape. Kenya is keenly aware of the impact of plastic on the wildlife and environment, and you will find mostly reusable containers for the lovely range of bathroom amenities. Solar is widely used for power. In the pristine wilderness you must look for the rare Grevy's zebra, Jackson's hartebeest, reticulated giraffe, and black rhino. This region is inhabited by multiple ethnic communities, including Kikuyus, Borana, Samburu, and more. Encounter some of these people on village visits and learn about their daily life, traditions and how they contribute to conservation. Enjoy wildlife drives with your expert ranger guides. Gather around the fire with your sundowners each evening and reminisce with your fellow travelers. This special place in Africa makes for a perfect ending to a magical experience.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Reservations and Payments: Deposits and payments for our Select Escorted Small Group Tours vary according to the individual itinerary. Payments may be made by check, wire transfer, American Express, VISA or MasterCard. Each Journey will have their own terms and conditions and will be sent out at time of booking with the detailed itinerary.

Payments Requirements: To confirm your reservation, we require an initial non-refundable payment of \$7,500 per person. Final payment is due by February 28, 2023.

Refunds & Cancellation Policy: All requests to cancel confirmed reservations must be received in writing. Cancellation fees are applicable to land, charter air, single supplement and extensions of any extra services. Any other special policies will be advised at time of booking.

COVID-19 ACCEPTANCE: Lakani World Tours travelers agree to submit required health documentation for travel and must comply with all Covid-19 protocols as directed by Lakani staff and local officials during their journey. Those who do not comply with these procedures will not be permitted to travel or continue on the tour. Lakani travelers must agree to assume all risks and related costs in the event that it becomes necessary to test or quarantine. Lakani World Tours may not be held responsible if travelers become infected with COVID-19 or experience travel interruption or delays as a result of the infection; travelers agree to bear any and all additional expenses associated with becoming infected.

Hotels: Based on two people sharing a room in deluxe or best available hotels. Single supplements apply for each journey for those requiring single accommodations and will be quoted at time of booking. Lakani reserves the right to substitute hotels for those named in the brochure when necessary.

Meals: Three meals per day on an a la carte and DINE BY CHOICE basis, wherever available and practical. Lakani Dine by Choice allows flexible dining in restaurants of the travelers' choosing. Bottled water, coffee and tea are included with meals.

Tour Manager: The services of the Lakani Tour Manager from arrival in the first city until the departure at the end of the tour.

Sightseeing: All sightseeing shown in the itinerary with English speaking guide via deluxe air-conditioned motorcoach where available or practical. Four-wheel drive vehicles may be used for sightseeing or safaris in certain areas such as Africa, as indicated in the itinerary. Entrance fees are included throughout.

Transfers: Individual arrival and departure transfers between airport and hotel to join and leave the journey.

Luggage: Transportation and transfer of two medium suitcases, except where by private charter air. Tours that include private charter air will have restrictions, and exact specifications on these tours will be sent at booking time.

Gratuities: All gratuities to hotel, restaurant and train staff, local guides and drivers.

Port Taxes: All port taxes on cruise portions of itineraries

Unused Services: Refunds will not be made for any missed/unused services or meals
