

Best Time to Visit:

JUN – SEP



Greenland is the world's largest island, a destination for travelers with a love of nature and a sense of adventure. A visit to Greenland is a fascinating and rewarding experience never to be forgotten for those prepared for the adventure. Accommodations are basic but comfortable and weather can be unpredictable.

Gigantic glaciers slide down from the Greenland ice-cap, breaking into majestic icebergs that float away down the still waters of the fjords. Deep valleys and sheltered inlets are covered with the varied and vividly colored vegetation of the Arctic.

Greenland can be a destination itself, or as flights are most often routed through Copenhagen or Reykjavik, combined with Denmark or Iceland, or other countries in northern Europe.

Lakani World Tours can create a travel itinerary best suited for you – based on your time, interests and budget. Recommended destinations include:

Southern Greenland - This area is considered the island's garden spot with lush valleys in the summer. Visit **Narsarsuaq**, the gateway to southern Greenland, where Viking sagas come to life in the ruins, fjords and villages. Take a fjord cruise to see the blue icebergs that are prominent here in the south. Experience the modern town of Narsaq mixing modern living with ancient traditions. In **Qaqortoq**, the biggest town in the south, there is a lively atmosphere and the only central square in the country with a fountain. Travel by boat to **Igaliku**, the oldest sheep farming settlement in Greenland, rolling valleys surrounded by tall mountain peaks provide a beautiful setting.

Nuuk - The capital region surrounds this city, the northernmost capital in the world. The heart of the nation, Nuuk, is a center of culture and modern living mixed with old traditions reflecting history. See expressions of the Inuit culture at the Nuuk Art Museum, learn more about the history at the Greenland National Museum, enjoy the natural scenery, perhaps sight a whale from shore and learn about local cuisine focused very much on the natural bounty.

North Greenland - As the location of the UNESCO World Heritage site, **Ilulissat** Icefjord, Ilulissat and **Disko Bay** are probably the most well-known locations in north Greenland, but the thousands of miles of coastline are home to small communities based on hunting and fishing. The Icefjord is a sculpture gallery and the sounds of icebergs cracking and rumbling can be heard all over town even when out of sight. Summer whale watching can be spectacular here with the iceberg backdrop; dog sledding a favorite past time in winter.

DAYS 1 – 2 • Meals: B (Day 2)**Reykjavik, ICELAND**

Arrive in Reykjavik where you are met and transferred to your luxury hotel. One of the world's smallest capitals, Reykjavik is believed to be the location of the first permanent settlement in Iceland and is now the heart of the country's cultural and economic activity. Gain an insider's view of the city with modern buildings and fresh bright colors on a city tour. Drive past Bessastaoir, the residence of the Icelandic President and gain a view of the city from the impressive Perlan observation deck.

Take a whale watching boat (May – Sep) to see the Minke, Humpback and other types of whales that call the North Atlantic home. Join the customized snow vehicle to ride across Langjokull Glacier and walk through the fascinating manmade ice tunnels. Observe the stunning Hraunfossar and Borgarfjord.

Hotel Borg**DAYS 3 – 4 • Meals: B, 1L****Hella**

On your way to Iceland's south coast, visit the Golden Circle where you find Iceland's Big Three: Gullfoss Waterfall, Geysir Geothermal Area, and Thingvellir National Park. Explore these scenic natural wonders and learn about their significance and history. The roots of how the island was formed can be found at Thingvellir, and it is an UNESCO World Heritage Site – the first one named for Iceland. Enjoy a visit to an Icelandic Horse stable. Drive by Super Jeep out to Thorsmork valley, situated between three glaciers, and the realm of the Thunder God, Thor. Witness the layers of a volcanic eruption from thousands of years ago as you join a walk into a lava tunnel and admire the colors on the walls from assorted minerals within the hardened lava.

Hotel Ranga**DAYS 5 – 6 • Meals: B****Hof**

Travel along the picturesque south coast with stunning waterfalls, volcano glaciers, and black sand beaches. Visit Vik, Iceland's southernmost village and an historically important trading post. Learn about Iceland's unique geology at the Lava Exhibit and molten lava show. Walk on the ice field of Solheimajokull Glacier. Explore Vatnajokull Glacier, the largest in the country. Hike an easy trail from Skaftafell to Svartifoss waterfall. Visit stunning Jokulsarlon Glacier Lagoon and board a zodiac for an exhilarating ride (May-Sep).

Fosshotel Glacier Lagoon**DAY 7 – 8 • Meals: B****Reykjavik & Depart Home**

Depart the south and head back to Reykjavik, stopping to explore sites along your route. On Day 8 transfer to the airport for your homeward or onward bound flight.

Denmark is the smallest country in Scandinavia, sharing Viking history, strong appreciation for design and a tendency to enjoy the outdoors with Norway, Sweden and Finland. It offers visitors plenty to see and do by itself or in an itinerary combined with one or more of the other north European countries.

Small, cozy cities (even the country's largest are on the small side), unexpected natural wonders as well as manmade design installations, historic castles and storybook villages provide many opportunities to explore this friendly nation.

Lakani World Tours can create a travel itinerary best suited for you – depending on your time, interests, and budget. Here are just some recommendations:

Copenhagen - Denmark's sophisticated capital city offers some of the most magical sightseeing. Here you see the Little Mermaid, the Royal Palace and visit the Crown Jewels at Rosenborg Castle and enjoy the fanciful Tivoli Gardens. Along the "Danish Riviera" have a view across to Sweden, visit Kronborg Castle featured in Shakespeare's *Hamlet*. Take a canal ride and visit colorful Nyhavn Harbour.

Odense – Located on the island of Fyn, this is the birthplace of Hans Christian Andersen, writer of fairy tales. Take a step back in time to a cozy town where you can walk in the author's footsteps. Visit the museum in the house where he was reportedly born, visit the Fairy Tale Garden or enjoy exploring the cobbled streets in the oldest sections of town.

Aarhus – the second largest city after Copenhagen is a design hotspot with something for everyone: modern art museum and shopping, the prehistory Moesgaard Museum, Viking history, a charming old town and lively pedestrian zones.

North Jutland – the country's far north includes **Aalborg** with a charming old town, spectacular waterfront of modern architecture and an ancient Viking burial site at Lindholm Hoje. At the top of Denmark, where the Baltic Sea meets the North Sea the windswept dunes and seaside heritage have combined in the artistic community of **Skagen**.

Jutland – mainland Denmark, the region attached to the European continent, includes 3 UNESCO World Heritage sites, the Viking Rune Stones monument at Jelling, Europe's best preserved Moravian city, Christiansfeld and the Wadden Sea National Park.



For those who love the idea of the great outdoors and are inspired by great design, Lakani World Tours can take you to visit Scandinavia and all that it has to offer. Plan to visit Denmark, Norway, Sweden and or Finland. Travel by plane, car, ferry or even dog sled to visit this amazingly beautiful area of the world. While the weather may be preferred in the summer, there is adventure to be enjoyed in the winter as well.

Your adventure may begin or end at any given point but might well begin in Helsinki, Finland where you will see and visit Esplanade Park, Market Square, Senate Square, Parliament, and a variety of museums. Copenhagen, Denmark is a sophisticated capital city that offers some of the most magical sightseeing. Here you will see the Little Mermaid, the Royal Palace and visit Rosenborg Castle and Tivoli Gardens. From Copenhagen you can visit North Sealand and Viking Land.

Take the ferry to Stockholm, Sweden where you will visit the Vasa Museum, the Royal Palace, the Gamla Stan and the Skansen Open-Air Museum. You might venture from the capital to Gothenburg and Malmö. Continue on to Norway and its capital of Oslo where you can visit Frogner Park, the Viking Ship Museum and Munch Museum. End your journey in Bergen and point north in the spectacular scenery of the fjords.

Depending on your interests, the time of year you travel and how adventurous you are you might consider doing some of the following:

- Travel by a variety of different methods throughout Scandinavia
- Plan your trip for winter and a stay at the ICEHOTEL in Jukkasjärvi, Sweden, some 200 kilometers / 125 miles north of the Arctic Circle. Here you may see the Northern Lights
- The following activities are all available in Scandinavia: walking, cycling, horseback riding, golf, swimming, kayaking, ice fishing, snowmobiling and/or dog sledding
- Charter a boat for a full day on the water in the fjords
- Shop for high fashion and interior and household items with the latest design trends

Encompassing three countries in one, you can experience its diversity – from the English metropolis of London to mysterious lake district in Scotland to the remote hills of Wales. And its relatively compact size makes it easy to explore its diverse offerings. You can visit a museum in the morning, a castle in the afternoon, and then take in an award-winning performance at night.

England – Mother England has it all, with London at its heart.

- Tour London to see the Tower of London and the Crown Jewels, the London Eye, Westminster Abbey, Houses of Parliament and the clock tower of Big Ben
- Appreciate the Victoria & Albert Museum, The National Gallery and other notable museums
- Journey beyond London to the City of Bath (UNESCO site) with stunning Georgian architecture and 2,000-year-old Roman baths

- Hop to nearby coastal islands or take a longer journey to the northern Orkney or Shetland islands
- Stop in a few distilleries on the Malt Whisky Trail to savor the true flavor of Scotland

Wales – A compact country with rugged coastal and mountain scenery and the oldest Celtic traditions of Britain.

- Visit the walkable Welsh capital of Cardiff and explore Cardiff Castle's nearly 2,000 year history
- Soak in beautiful Wye Valley, visit Chepstow Castle along a limestone cliff and the ruins of gothic Tintern Abbey
- Travel by narrow gauge railway to Snowdon Summit, for the views that might include Ireland
- Fall in love with picturesque North Wales's seaside towns and unique Portmeirion, an Italianate village created in the 1920s as a tourist destination.
- Trace the life of Welsh poet, Dylan Thomas, in Swansea, Gower and Laugharne, West Wales





Malta is a fascinating yet small Mediterranean archipelago set between Sicily and the North African coast. It offers a mild climate, impressive fossil-studded cliffs, colorful plants and the clear beauty of the Mediterranean Sea. Malta is known for its diverse historic sites built by a succession of rulers including the Romans, Moors, Knights of Saint John, French, and British. As early as 4000 B.C. large temples were built indicating a highly developed and sophisticated civilization, but it was under the Knights of St John that developed Malta culturally and artistically, creating beautiful palaces, churches, fortifications and work of art.

Valletta is the capital and medieval fortress city, and a UNESCO World Heritage site due to its large number and concentration of historical buildings. Highlights include the Baroque St John's Co-Cathedral containing two Caravaggio paintings, the Palace of the Grand Masters, Upper Barrakka Gardens, and the fortress of St. James Cavalier.

Mdina, Malta's old capital, is a well-preserved walled medieval city, also called the Silent City. It is in the center of Malta and offers amazing views across the plains to the coastline.

Blue Grotto is a series of seven caves and inlets famous for deep blue waters and spectacular natural rock formations. It is accessible only by small traditional boats.

Gozo is a rural island whose Dwejra Bay features dive sites including the Blue Hole (an underwater chimney) and the Inland Sea lagoon. It can be a day-trip from Malta, or you can over-night at one of the 4-star hotels.

The Canaries, as they are commonly called, are a group of the most populated volcanic islands off the coast of Africa in the Atlantic. They are a Spanish autonomous community with seven main islands, including Tenerife, Gran Canaria, Lanzarote, La Palma, La Gomera, and El Hierro, and many smaller islands and islets. Due to their individual locales with respect to the north-east trade winds, climates vary from mild and wet to very dry. Therefore, the islands have distinctive microclimates.


Prior to the arrival of humans, the islands were inhabited by prehistoric animals like the giant lizard, giant rats, and giant tortoises. Settlers arrived in the islands most likely two or three thousand years ago, and there is evidence that they came from the North African coast. In the following centuries, the islands came under attack from Castilians, Portuguese, Ottomans, Dutch, French, and more. Highlights of Old Town include the intricate Robba Fountain, Dragon Bridge, an Art Nouveau masterpiece adorned with dragons (the symbol of Ljubljana), and vibrant produce markets. Walk the cobble streets and ride the funicular to Ljubljana Castle, towering over the city.

Bled - One of Europe's most fascinating and beautiful cities, whose thermal springs have drawn seekers of healing treatments for centuries. Perched on a cliff above the emerald waters of **Lake Bled**, is the oldest castle in Slovenia with a Romanesque tower built in the early 11th century. A must do is taking a traditional pletna boat cruise to **St. Mary's Island** to visit the church built into a rock and ring it's famed "wishing bell."

Istria - Experience Slovenia's portion of the Adriatic coast. Piran, Portoroz and Koper are some of the small coastal cities here that were once part of the Venetian Republic.

Various - Go underground in one or more of the caves found in Slovenia's **Karst region**. See the famous Lipizzaner horses in their homeland. Visit **Predjama Castle**, a dramatic fortress on a rock face. Enjoy the natural wonders of **Triglav National Park** and **Lake Bohinj**.



Croatia is a popular country for visitors on the Adriatic Coast. This Balkan country offers gorgeous scenery along the coast and in interior National Parks, picturesque villages and historic cities, Roman ruins and UNESCO sites. Influences from surrounding countries date back to the Roman Empire and various unions with principalities of Italy and the Hapsburg Empire through history are seen architecture, palaces, castles and food throughout the country.

Croatia can be combined with many neighboring countries, such as Montenegro, Slovenia and Italy.

Split on the mainland coast is a 1700-year-old town, that enticed the Roman Emperor Diocletian to build a palace for his retirement. The town has grown well beyond the palace walls and has a Venetian atmosphere and waterfront promenade.

PLITVICE LAKES – Plitvice Lakes National Park is considered the most beautiful park in Croatia, it is a UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site. Tour this magnificent park of 16 lakes, waterfalls, forests, and animal life.

ZAGREB – In the interior historic Zagreb is the capital of Croatia. The Upper Town is the historical center with St. Mark’s Church topped with a multicolored roof. The noon hour is marked with the firing of a cannon at the top of fortified Lotrščak Tower to commemorate a legendary event thought to have saved the city from attackers.

TRAKOSCAN CASTLE –Outside Zagreb in a dreamlike wooded setting Trakoscan Castle stands, dating back to 1334. Walk through the halls furnished with many pieces from a world gone by.
